Thank you for supporting our Monday/Wednesday STEAM (Science, Technology/Engineering, Arts, Math) and Tuesday/Thursday Humanities (English, Social Studies, PE, World Language) remote learning schedule and encouraging your child to complete all assignments. Here are your THORSday end of the year updates...

Thursday, May 14 – Friday, May 15, 10AM – 3PM: Lesher teachers return to school to

clean out classrooms and prepare for materials and laptop return May 20 – 22.

Friday, May 15: Last day secondary teachers will introduce new content/material. Students can still complete assignments and meet with teachers online until Friday, May 22.

Monday, May 18 – Friday, May 22: Teachers continue to connect with students, accept work and provide feedback.

Friday, May 22: Last day of remote learning.

Wednesday, May 20 – Friday, May 22, 10AM – 3PM: Student locker clean-out, library book, textbook and laptop return. Yearbook distribution.

- ✓ Staff and students must wear mask/face covering (i.e. bandana).
- ✓ Hand sanitizer will be available in the building.
- ✓ Stay at least 6-ft apart.
- ✓ No congregating inside or outside the building.
- ✓ Individuals with COVID symptoms or a fever may not enter the building.
- ✓ Only your student can enter the building and has 20 minutes to complete this process.
- ✓ Parents please drop off your child at our main west entrance (Stover St.) to check in and pick up around back at our east pick up/drop off lane (Ellis St.) by the shade structure.
- ✓ STEP 1- Gather personal belongings and empty hallway, PE and/or music lockers.
- ✓ *STEP 2* Turn in Lesher instruments on the stage.
- ✓ STEP 3- Turn in novels, textbooks, calculators and class-specific materials at that teacher's classroom.
- ✓ STEP 4- Turn in chargers, laptops, and library books at these locations: 6th Cafeteria, 7th Main Gym, 8th Media Center.
- ✓ STEP 5- Pick up Yearbook at these locations: 6th Cafeteria, 7th Main Gym, 8th Media Center.
- ✓ STEP 6- Exit across the patio. Parents pick up is our east pick up/drop off area (Ellis St.) by the shade structure and shed.
- ✓ If you would like to purchase a Yearbook see Mrs. Mitchell in the main office.
