From the Principal

May 21, 2021

Dear Viking F-A-M-I-L-Y (Students, Parents & Staffulty):

Thank you for your flexibility, support, patience, and understanding during what has been a very difficult year for so many. We made it through. During this final quarter we were able to bring back some sense of normalcy with daily in-person instruction, endof-year band, orchestra, and choir concerts, a bike-to-school day, three shortened sports seasons, the final competitions of our eSports club, and our 8th grade afternoon/ yearbook signing/talent show/game show and last half day 3K run/walk Lesher Fest to send our 8th graders off in good fashion who spent 5 of their 12 middle school quarters (42%) in a pandemic. We also saw the impact of a year plus of remote learning and social isolation as students returned to the building full time. There was an uptick in student stress and anxiety that showed itself in the form of increased student misbehavior as they returned to the day-to-day. What we intentionally plan to establish relationships, build culture and set expectations from day one matter, and when those opportunities are limited, we see an impact on courtesy, communication, and collaboration.





PHS Awards Ubuntu Scholarship

Purpose: Oftentimes the highly motivated, involved students in middle schools come to a large high school and fade into the sea of students. Without being noticed, some fall through the cracks. Middle school teachers and principals know these "diamonds in the rough." Our goal would be to give students a "carrot" in middle school to stay involved and in good academic standing throughout their high school years. This carrot would be in the form of scholarship \$ to be used at a college of the student's choice should the student follow certain criteria during their 4 years at Poudre High School. It's also designed to motivate students early, rather than awarding a student a scholarship at their 11th grade year when they've already had 2 years to fall behind.

Archbishop Desmond Tutu offered a definition of Ubuntu: "A person with Ubuntu is open and available to others, affirming of others, does not feel threatened that others are able and good, based from a proper self-assurance that comes from knowing that he or she belongs in a greater whole and is diminished when others are humiliated or diminished, when others are tortured or oppressed. Ubuntu speaks particularly about the fact that you can't exist as a human being in isolation. It speaks about our interconnectedness. You can't be human all by yourself, and when you have this quality – Ubuntu – you are known for your generosity. We think of ourselves far too frequently as just individuals, separated from one another, whereas you are connected and what you do affects the whole World. When you do well, it spreads out; it is for the whole of humanity."

This year, PHS awarded to Ubuntu scholarship to Miki Mijidorj, with Betsy Bain coming in as his runner up. Congrats to you Miki, and we wish you well at PHS!




Lesher is looking for gardening volunteers over the summer!

PSD Transportation 2021-22

Need busing in 2021-22? PSD bus request process now open.

- Students who currently receive transportation services for the 2020-21 school year will be prioritized for busing
 for next school year. Their families do not need to take any action steps at this time unless the following
 changes apply, and Transportation will notify families of route information sometime after Aug. 1 and before
 the start of school. If a current rider will have a change in addresses, change in schools or is moving from Early
 Childhood Education to kindergarten, they need to submit a bus request to be considered for services.
- Families will get a pop-up notification after submitting their request. Changes can be made to an application in ParentVUE up until the June 30 deadline.
- Students who did NOT receive busing in 2020-21 must submit a request.
- Requesting transportation is not a guarantee of service.
