



# **Traffic Safety at Lesher Middle School**

#### In the interest of student, parent, & staff safety:

#### **Drivers**

- Slow down
- Drop-off/pick-up students at designated times & places
- PULL FORWARD in the drop-off/pick-up area
- Yield to pedestrians & crossing guards in crosswalks
- DO NOT BLOCK the roadway, bicycle lanes, handicap spaces, bus entrances, or driveways
- NO parking, stopping, or standing at RED CURBS
- DO NOT make u-turns on streets around the school

#### Bicyclists/Skateboarders

- Bicycles should use bicycle lanes
   & obey traffic laws
- Dismount your bicycle/ skateboard on the sidewalk in front of the school & walk
- Secure your bicycle/skateboard on the racks at the north side of the school

#### **Pedestrians**

- Use crosswalks
- Make eye contact with drivers prior to crossing
