Registration

Pre-Registration will open in early October through Track Wrestling. The cost will be \$30 per entrant with a No Refund Policy. There will also be registration the day of the event, but the tournament is capped at 150 entries so pre-registration is advised.

Divisions

Grades K-2, 3-4, 5-6, and 7-8 will have separate divisions with boys and girls wrestling in the same division. Wrestlers will be grouped to create a round-robin or 8-wrestler double elimination bracket based on the number of participants. If Necessary, we will combine appropriate divisions between age group and/or weights to ensure your athlete gets matches.

Weigh-Ins

Wrestlers will be grouped by weight class in their appropriate age group based on registration. Honor system will be used for weights, but a wrestler's weight can be challenged by faculty if there is an apparent difference.

Officials:

Trained CSU Wrestlers will serve as officials.

Rules:

2022-2023 NFHS Rules apply unless otherwise indicated. There will be Three 1 ½ minute periods (1-minute periods for K-2, and 3-4). As always, pin, or technical fall completes the match

Spectators:

There will be a \$5 spectator entry fee at the door as well as coaching mat side wristbands for an additional \$10. Seating will be limited so bringing foldable chairs is recommended.

Awards:

The top three place finishers per weight will receive a medal.





Traffic Safety at Lesher Middle School

1400 Stover St. | Fort Collins

To help streamline drop-off and pick-up, please adhere to Lesher's Traffic Safety. The area directly in front of the main entrance is designated to busses only. The main entrance and cafeteria entrance are the only entry points to the building; however, during school hours, you must come through the front office.



Drivers

- Slowdown
- · PULLFORWARD in the drop-off/pick-up area
- Yield to pedestrians & crossing guards in crosswalks
- DO NOT BLOCK the roadway, bicycle lanes, handicap spaces, bus entrances, or driveways
- NO parking, stopping, or standing at REDCURBS

Bicyclists/Skateboarders

- Bicycles should use bicycle lanes & obey traffic laws
- Dismount your bicycle/ skateboard on the sidewalk in front of the school & walk
- Secure your bicycle/skateboard on the racks at the north side of the school

Pedestrians

- Use crosswalks
- Make eye contact with drivers prior to crossing
