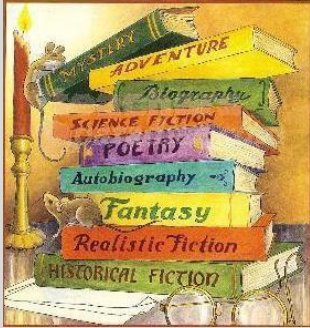


40 Book Challenge!

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Genres Challenge



Students attempt to read

one book from each of the following genres:

Fiction (realistic/historical)

Non-Fiction

Mystery/Suspense

Fantasy

Science Fiction

Graphic Novels

Classics/Traditional

Poetry

Biography/Autobiography

Global Literature

Things to Consider:

- Audio books and graphic novels DO count towards your goal of 40.
- You may go beyond 40 books.
- You DO NOT have to read one book from each genre.

Vikings take on the 40 Book Challenge!



Starting on May 1st, Vikings will take on the 40 Book Challenge! Every student at Lesher Middle School will be challenged to read 40 books in one year.

Students who participate will be invited to a Book Fiesta at the end of the year and awarded a prize.

Research shows that children who read consistently can see benefits in many aspects of their futures including academics, social skills, and even level of income. Ultimately, however, our goal is to help students find books they love and develop a life-long habit of reading!

How to participate:

Read a book!

- Try to read at least one book from each genre = 10/40
- Choose 30 other books to reach your goal of 40!

Keep track!

- Ask your Language and Literature teacher for a Reading Log
- Record all the books you read this year in your Reading Log.
- Include the book title, author name, and genre.

Collect a prize!

- Turn in your Reading Log to your Language and Literature teacher.
- 10+ books = Invite to the Book Fiesta
- 40+ books = A special prize!!
